Praise Reports: *From the International Student Ministries:* Met with students leaving Arkansas for the summer. We taught about being led by the Holy Spirit and encouraged each one to do Jesus Disciple while school is not in session (since they never did Territory 1 while in school). Seven students that we've built relationships with and prayed over have graduated.
