Leading ministry in a prison and a local church in Guaymas, Mexico

Making disciples in the Caribbean

Praise Reports: In Haiti, the community of Lerminthe hosted its first-ever “25 Families Meal,” which became a community meal feeding nearly 200 people. An after-meal medical clinic treated 84 individuals. The 25 families in Lerminthe held their first meeting, organizing into 3 Discovery Bible Study (DBS) groups led by Jean, Moises, and Jonathan. The goal is for every family to become a DBS family.

Prayer Requests: Haiti: For new medical, agricultural, and food leaders in Haiti to lead with wisdom and a focus on making disciple-makers. Cuba: Favor, wisdom, and Holy Spirit anointing for the Cuba trip, November 10–17.

Making disciples among international students

Praise Reports: Barbara returned from Nassau. Thankful for the powerful work of God through their student team—many lives were transformed. At the High School Camp, 31 students chose to follow Jesus and several were physically healed, while at the College Camp, many rededicated their lives and formed new friendships. As international students began arriving, simple moments of meals and shopping reminded them of how God speaks even through everyday life.

Prayer Requests: Pray for grace and guidance for returning students, especially those from Central America, as many Haitian and Caribbean students have graduated and others are preparing to graduate in 2026. Pray that new international students connect deeply with the ministry and that student gatherings would be filled with spiritual hunger, worship, and transformation. Pray for strength and endurance for us as we faithfully continue the work God has called us.

Making disciples in West Australia

Praise Reports: We have found temporary housing with our host family while we continue to search for permanent accommodations. We were also able to find an affordable family car. We have been welcomed in by the Foursquare family, and are starting to branch out in the community to build relationships with young adults and leaders. Alisha has been asked to create and lead the entire Kids Ministry program for the upcoming National Foursquare Connection.

Prayer Requests: Pray that we can find affordable accommodations in a central location in Perth. Pray for open doors to build connections and relationships in the community.

Making disciples in Fiji

Praise Reports: I’m excited to share that I’ve started serving with Abide Youth during my time here — it’s been such a blessing to walk alongside these young hearts and see God moving in their lives.

Prayer Requests: Pray for me as I prepare to leave in October for a 4-month mission to Fiji, as we minister in areas with strong Hindu and Islamic influences, believing that God’s Word will break through barriers and transform lives. One of the practical needs is raising \$6,500, and I ask for prayer that this is met so local families can experience something life-giving during the holiday season.

Discipling people in the Middle East

Praise Reports: (Arab Peninsula) Brian is thriving in his new administration role, where he’s seeing increased effectiveness and God’s hand at work, while Stacy continues to impact patients by offering care that reflects Jesus’ love. Their family is enjoying peace and stronger bonds with a shorter commute and balanced schedules, and they’re grateful for deepening relationships with neighbors and friends as well as God’s daily protection. Support from partners has encouraged them greatly, helping cover half of their children’s tuition, and they remain confident in God’s faithful provision for the rest.

Prayer Requests: Pray for Brian to have wisdom, favor, and discernment in his new role, and for Stacy to continue carrying Christ’s love in her patient care. Ask for peace and encouragement for their children, protection and discernment in relationships, and that seeds planted among local friends and patients would grow into lasting fruit, with Jesus revealed clearly to Muslims in their circles. Finally, lift up their need for continued provision, that God would stir new partners and strengthen support to cover schooling and ministry needs.

Discipling people in Native American Reservations across the United States

Praise Reports: We built the mobile coffee shop and used it to serve our Crow family at their camp at Crow Fair. Seventy kids (including 14 foster children) and 7 single moms, who had initially planned to abort but chose life through the help of a ministry, attended Arise Native American Family Camp, where the Holy Spirit moved powerfully.

Prayer Requests: Pray for us to finish the coffee roaster, and for an intern to run it. Pray as we continue to build a flea market for locals to sell their goods, for the upcoming Arise Young Adult Camp at Soboba Reservation, and for Mo and family, as their mother is in pain and her health continues to decline.
